DECLARED CONTENTS

13% w/w water soluble Manganese (Mn)
13% w/w Manganese (Mn) chelated by EDTA
pH range guaranteeing acceptable stability of the chelated fraction: 4-9

DESCRIPTION

GO-Chelate Mn is a phytonutrient which contains manganese chelated by EDTA, in microgranular form and with high solubility. It is recommended for prevention and correction of manganese deficiencies in all types of crops and soils.

DOSAGE AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Cereals (wheat, barley, rye): 3-4 kg/ha (1 to 2 applications). Apply in the first stage of the cycle (2 leaves).

Spring rape: 3-4 kg/ha. Apply in the stage of 4 to 6 leaves. Repeat at 10-14 days.

Winter rape: 3-4 kg/ha. Apply in the stage of 4 to 6 leaves. Repeat at 10-14 days.

Maize forage: 3-4 kg/ha (1 to 2 applications). Apply in the first stage of the cycle.

Peas and beans: 2-6 kg/ha. Apply in the first stage of the cycle (4-6 leaves). Repeat for 2-4 applications through the season.

Potato: 2-6 kg/ha. Apply in the first stage of the cycle (4-6 leaves). Repeat for 2-4 applications through the season.

COMPATIBILITY

GO-Chelate Mn is compatible with most fertilizers commonly used in agriculture.

It is recommended to carry out tests before mixing the product. DO NOT mix **GO-Chelate Mn** with cupric, organo-cupric and oily products, sulphur or alkaline products. To be used only where there is a recognised need. Do not exceed the appropriate dose rates.

STORAGE CONDITIONS

Keep between 5°C and 35°C in a dry and ventilated place.

Note: *The recommended dosages, here detailed, are indicative, only the user can increase them or reduce them according to the plant vegetative stage and the soil.*
